The 225g canister contains enough Bear Spray for 5 seconds of continuous spray, the 400g canister contains 7 seconds of continuous spray.

The pepper ingredient (Capsaicinoids) causes an immediate and involuntary shutdown of the animal's functions and prevents the completion of a charge.

Bear Spray is non-toxic and does not cause any lasting harm to the animal. It is a safer and more effective option for protection, while ultimately protecting bear populations as well. Bear Shield Bear Spray has a secure glow-in-the-dark safety tab and can be deployed quickly in an emergency.

HOW BEAR SPRAY WORKS

Bear spray stops bears in their tracks by dispersing a pepper cloud up to 10.7m for the 225g can (35ft). Bear Spray is the single most effective protection to carry when in bear country. Bears move very quickly, bear spray should be readied for use when the animal is 30m (100ft) away. It is useful to practice the drawing motion with the safety on or use the **Inert Training Spray** to practice deployment.

Although rare, bear attacks on humans have occurred, inflicting serious injuries and death. Each bear and each interaction with a bear is unique. Bear spray is the best protection you can carry in the widest variety of situations. Most bear encounters end quickly and without injury. Following some basic guidelines may help to lessen the threat of danger.

HOW TO USE BEAR SPRAY

Know how to use bear spray and **ALWAYS** carry bear spray when you're in the wilderness

CHECK THE EXPIRY on your bear spray.

Like any aerosol-based spray product, after the expiry, the propellant deteriorates and will not expel the product at the desired range.

Choose destinations away from known bears, travel in groups and make noise while in the wilderness.

Step 1:
REMOVE SAFETY

Every can of bear spray comes with a safety latch, this will need to be removed in order to deploy the bear spray.

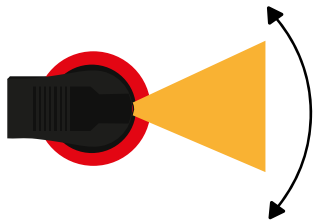


Step 2:
PRESS TRIGGER

Hold the can with two hands, placing one on the trigger. To deploy, press the trigger with your thumb.

Step 3:
SPRAY IN BURSTS

When you are in range of the bear, aim for the nose and eyes, spraying in bursts.



Step 4:
RETURN TO SAFETY

Once you are safe, the safety tab should be returned to the bear spray canister to avoid any remaining bear spray from accidentally being deployed.
